



Consent for Use of Student Names and Images

Throughout the school year, schools and the district communications team take photos and videos to share district news and events on our website and social media channels that can be seen by the public.

Additionally, teachers and schools may take photos for internal school purposes only such as school bulletin boards or on privacy-reviewed platforms such as Google Classroom.

Please note that at school events such as concerts or track and field events, the district does not prohibit parents or family members from taking photos. We ask caregivers to not post photos of other people's children taken at school events on their social media accounts.

We will ensure that your child's name and image are not used in any school-related stories, media visits, or other public platforms unless we have your explicit permission through this consent form.

Walk/Run Field Trips

The classroom curriculum is significantly enriched and expanded when students visit and observe certain aspects of community life and the natural environment. A typical school neighbourhood field trip might include activities such as science walks to study local vegetation, a visit to a local library, or a cross-country run. School field trips provide valuable educational experiences and are planned as an enriched part of the total school program.

Guidelines are in place governing the number of supervisors who will accompany students on each school field trip. These guidelines also apply to walk/run field trips. Walk/run field trips will not exceed approximately 4km distance from the school. Every reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of students. No regular walk/run field trip will exceed one day.
